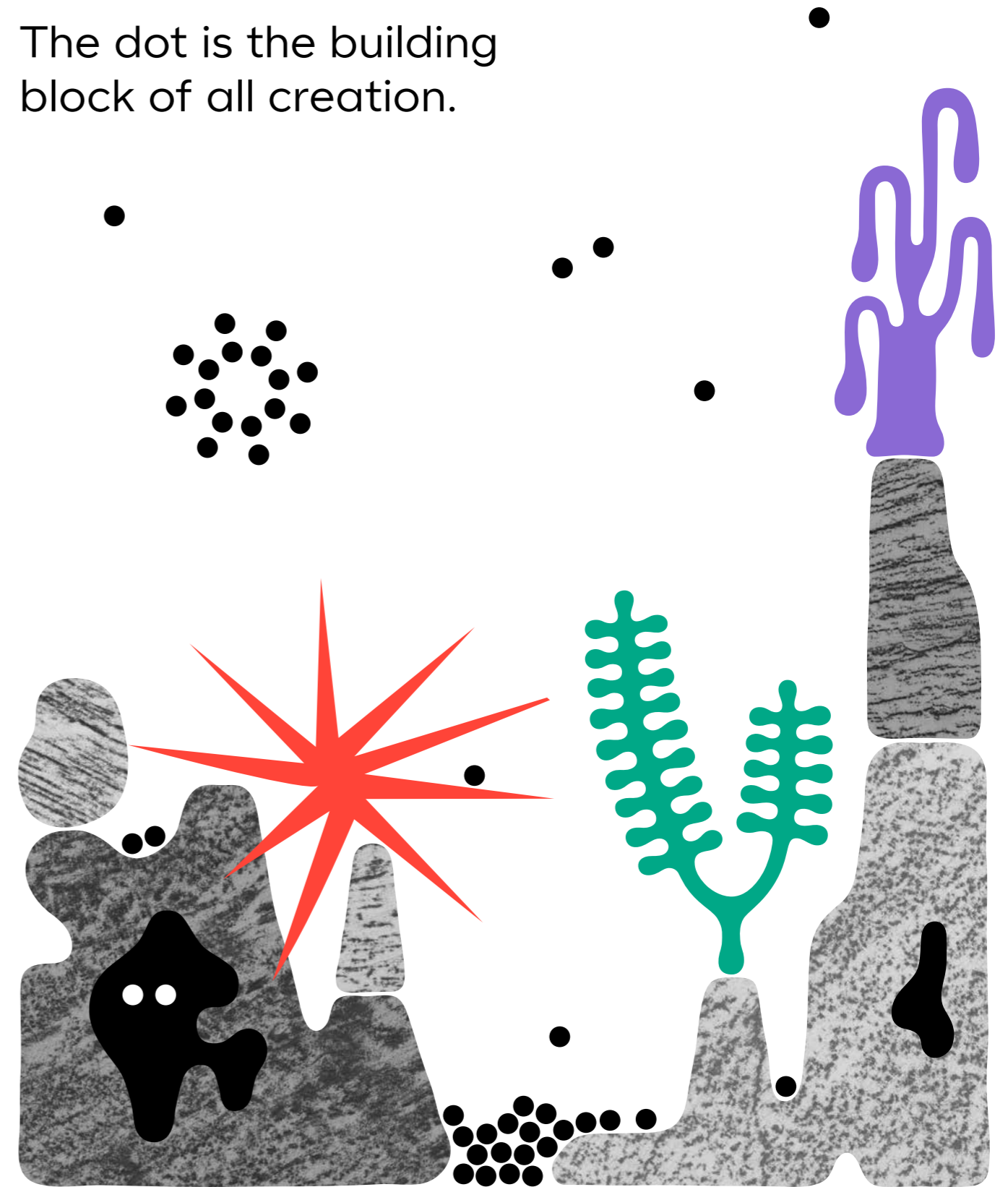
# The Dot

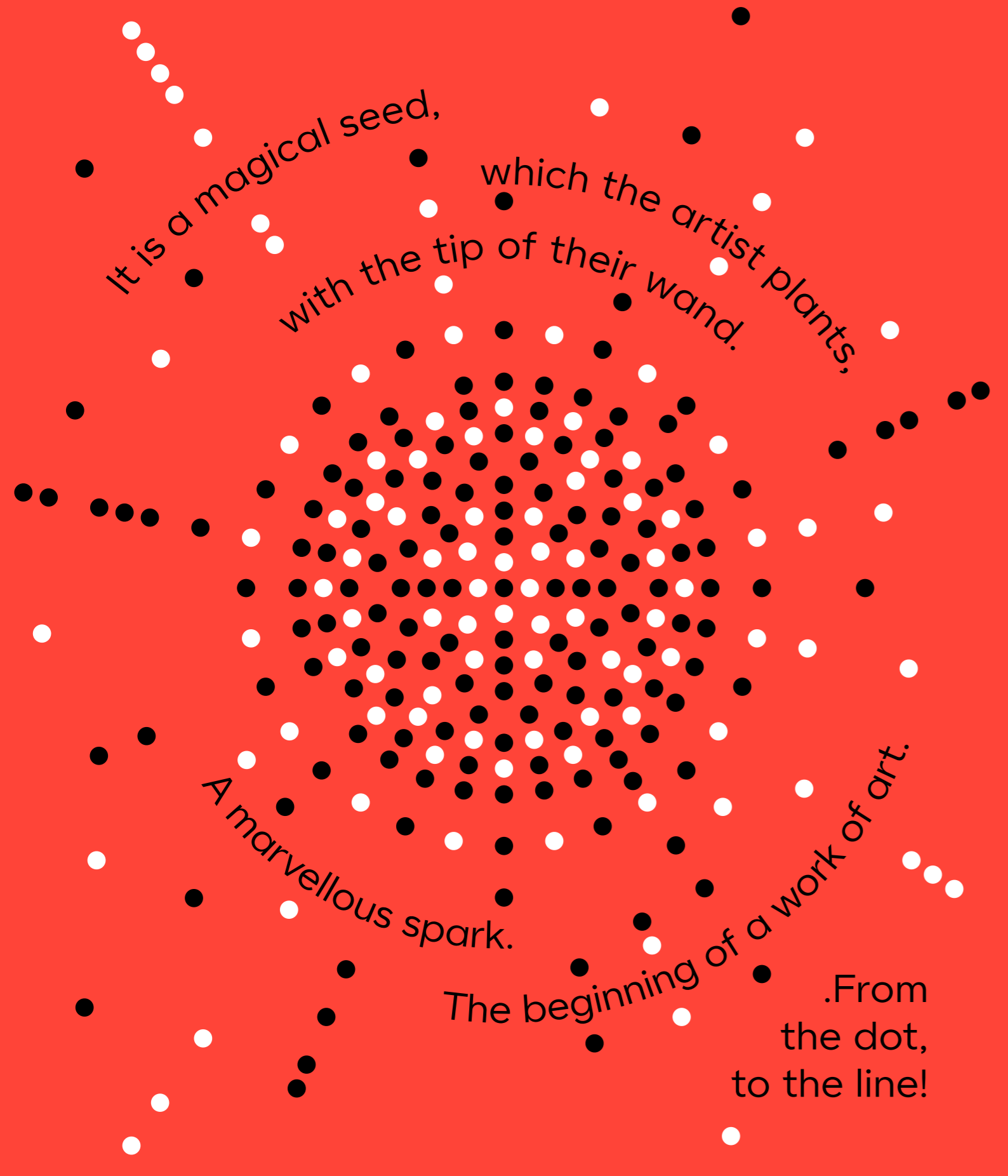

to the line!



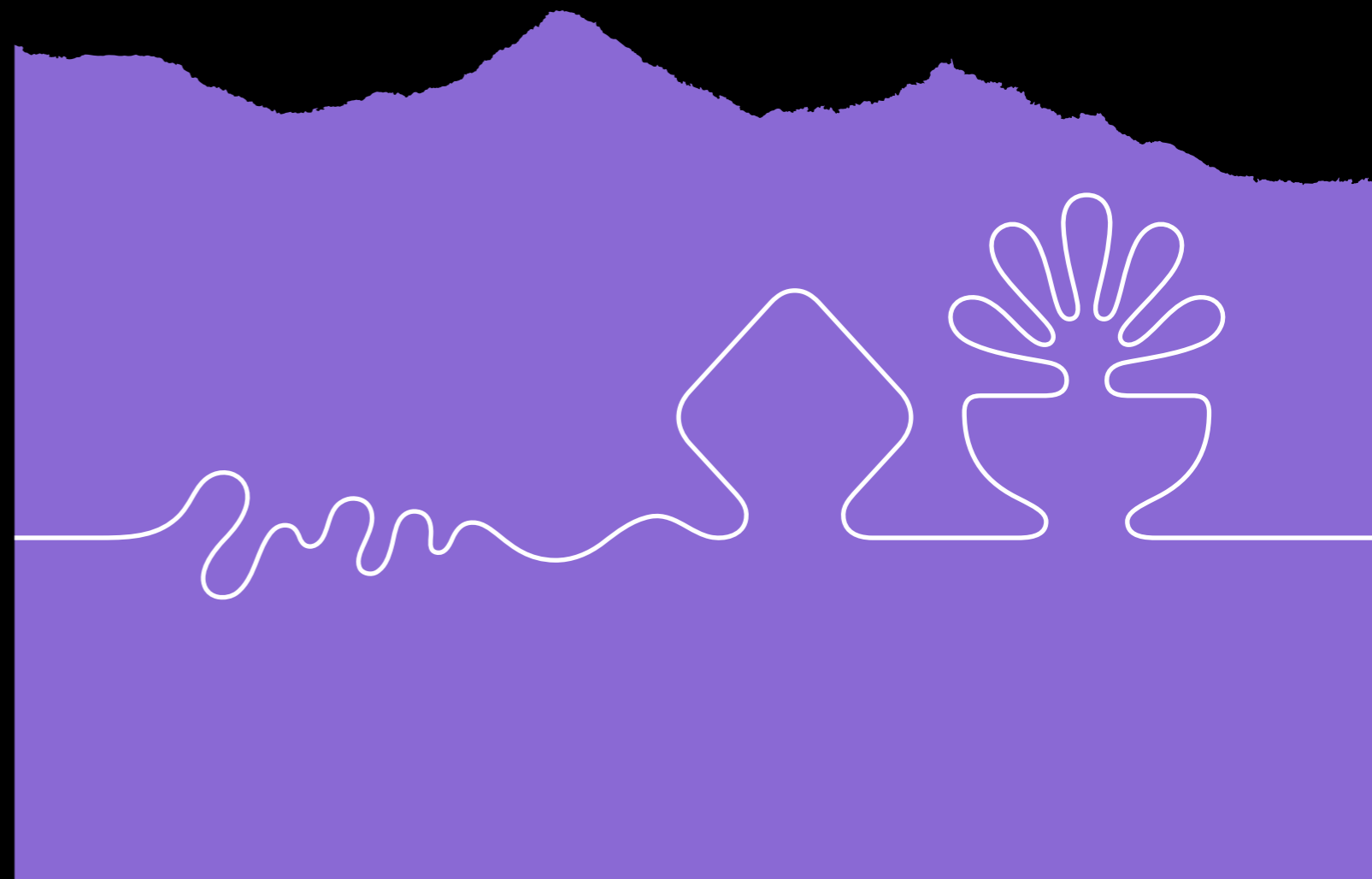
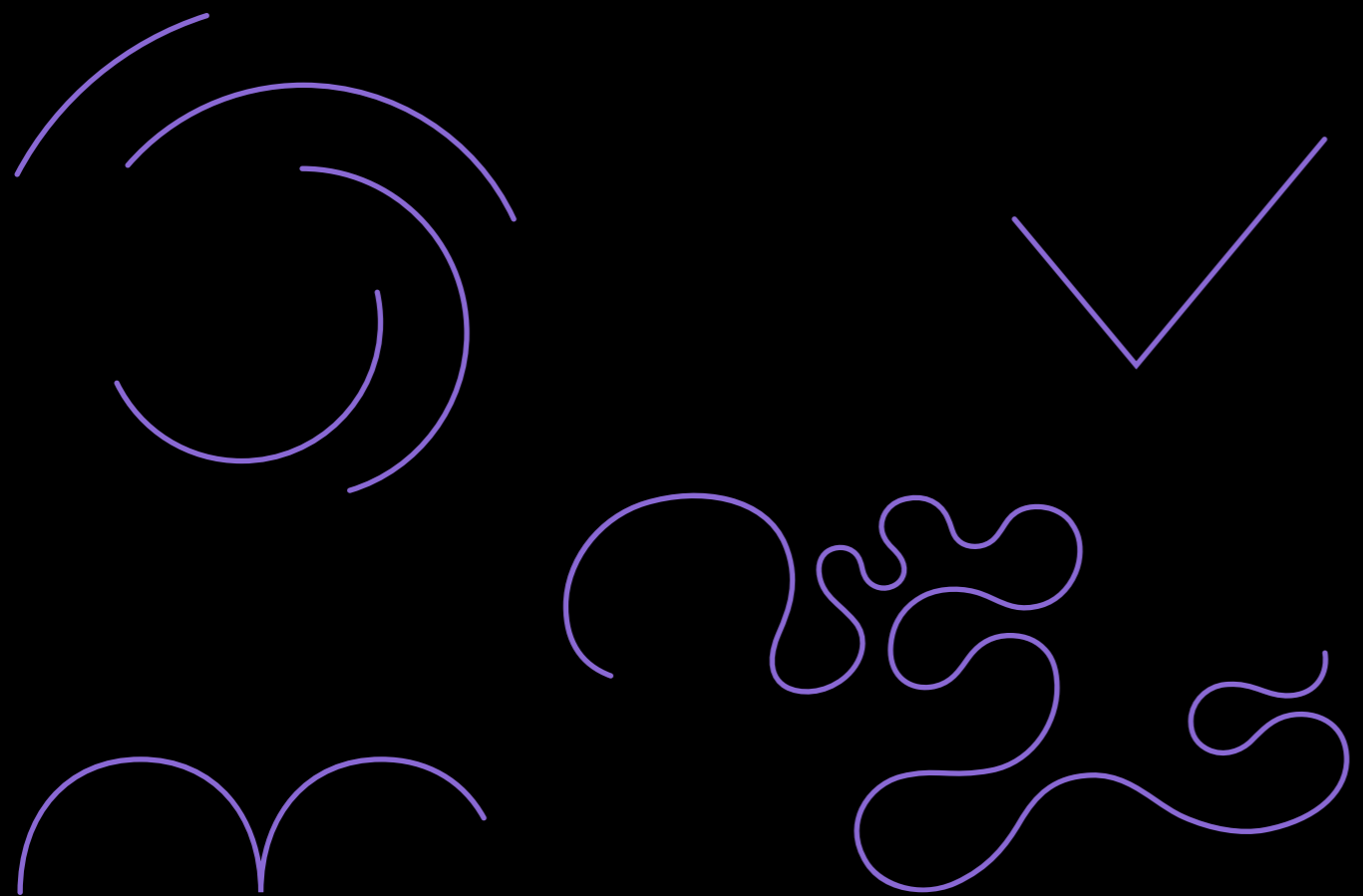
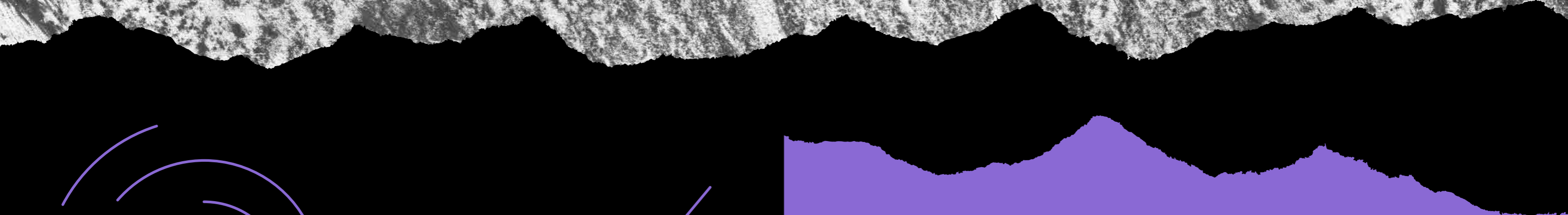
# The Line
